Services Provided:

Biological investigations and NEPA compliance for implementation of a US Army Corps Section 404 permit, design and installation of a creek channel, wildlife monitoring, and compliance with Teton County land development regulations

Details of PIONEER Involvement:

As a prime environmental contractor, Pioneer completed an analysis of the biotic, abiotic, and human resources for the entire project area. An Environmental Assessment, Habitat Conservation Plan, 404 Permit, 404(b) 1 Alternatives Analysis, Cultural Assessment, and recreation assessment were prepared. Section 10 and Section 7 consultation processes were developed by Pioneer in preparation for a provision for incidental take under the Endangered Species Act. Construction scheduling and planning was under the direction of Pioneer whenever and wherever there was a threat to bald eagles. Design of over two miles of new stream that included mitigation sites for wetlands was done by Pioneer. Pioneer also completed the extensive environmental processes required by Teton County which addressed wildlife, threatened and endangered plants and animals, wetlands, riparian areas, special habitats, visual concerns, public access, economic viability, transportation, and regulation compliance.
